- Fill the box with toys, school supplies, hygiene items, and/or clothing for a boy or girl (ages 2-14).
- o Families are encouraged to write a note to include in their box.
- o Drop off filled box(es) in the church lobby or office by Sunday, November 16.

2. Build a Shoebox Online

- o In just a few clicks, you can choose toys, fun items, and even add a letter and photo for a child.
- o After shipping, local believers share the Gospel as shoeboxes are distributed.


3. Donate Online


Mom's in Community
